\$300,000 LIBRARY BOOK FINE

Librarians in New York’s oldest library have uncovered a surprising borrower with overdue books – George Washington. On 5 October 1789, the first president of the United States of America checked out two books from the library in Manhattan. **1.**_____ His assistant simply wrote “president” next to the titles to show who had taken them out.

2._____ As a result they were able to confirm that one of the books checked out by Washington was still missing. It appeared the president had failed to return it. **3.**_____ For being more than 221 years late the borrower should pay a fine of \$300,000 at today’s prices. The library issued a statement. The head librarian Mark Bartlett said: “**4.**_____ However, we would be very happy if we were able to get the missing book back.”

After staff at Mount Vernon, Washington’s former home in Virginia, learned of the situation, they got in touch with the library. **5.**_____ On 19 May 2010 the library hosted a ceremony at which it was presented by the Mount Vernon staff.
